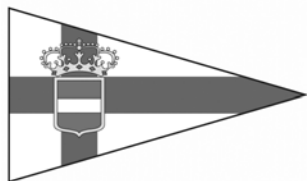

# NOTICE OF RACE



### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RSS).
- 1.2 If there is a conflict between this NOR and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail.

### 2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

### 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to boats of the Devoti One class that meet the with the obligations of the class rules.
- 3.2 The helmsman of the boat shall be member of their National Devoti D-one Class Association or the International D-one Class Association.
- 3.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form on [www.uyc-wolfgangsee.at](http://www.uyc-wolfgangsee.at)  
Due date is 20th of May.

### 4 FEES

- 4.1 The entry fee will be 150 EUR, cash at the registration in the race office.  
This includes as a minimum:
  - Boat and trailer storage for the duration of the event
  - One "normal" dinner, one "Championship Dinner" (and a lot of beer!)
  - Regatta souvenir
- 4.2 Late entry fee (Online Registration after 20<sup>th</sup> of May): 30 EUR

### 5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Registration: 30th May: 5pm-7pm, 31st May: 8am-10am  
Briefing: 31st May 10:30 am  
Dates of practice race: 30th May  
Dates of races 31st-3<sup>rd</sup> June
- 5.4 Number of races: 8 races are scheduled over 4 consecutive days, 2 races are scheduled each per day. If there are less than two races possible on a day, there can be three races on the next day.
- 5.5 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the practice race is 3:30pm 30th May  
The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 12 am 31st May.

## **6 MEASUREMENTS**

- 6.1 Random equipment inspections may be undertaken by the D-One International Class Association.
- 6.2 To apply wide wing setting: helms shall be weighted during the registration period. RRS 43.1 shall apply.

## **7 VENUE**

## **8 THE COURSES**

- 8.1 The course to be sailed will be windward-leeward configuration.
- 8.2 Target time for the lead-boat to finish each race will be 60 minutes.

## **9 PENALTY SYSTEM**

Rule 44.2 is changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one jibe, is required.

## **10 SCORING**

- 10.1 The scoring system is Low Point System.
- 10.2 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 10.3 When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst scores.

## **11 SUPPORT BOATS**

Support boats have to be registered with an email to: [office@uyc-wolfgangsee.at](mailto:office@uyc-wolfgangsee.at) until 20th of May.

Support boats shall be marked as decided by the organising authority. In emergency case they have to help the race officials.

## **12 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

## **13 PRIZES**

Prizes will be given as follows:

1st -5th overall

1st -3rd master (50 years of age or over on the first day of the event)

## **14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

It is the competitor's free decision to enter the regatta or to start and continue in any race. Competitors shall accept that their participation in the regatta is at their exclusive risk in every respect. (See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race).

The Organising Authority and the respective Host Sailing Club (UYC Wolfgangsee), their officers, members, servants and agents accept no responsibility in respect of loss of life, personal injury or loss or damage to property which may be sustained by reason of their participation or intended participation in the regatta or howsoever arising in connection with the regatta.

The safety equipment of the boats has to match with the class rules

## **15 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1,5m EUR per incident or the equivalent.

## **16 ACCOMODATION**

The village of St. Gilgen is situated on lake Wolfgangsee (30 km near Salzburg) and is a holiday resort with accomodation possibilities in all price classes. Please book your accomodation at the Wolfgangsee tourism company in St. Gilgen:
